ColorAll Fingering Chart

Need help with fingering? ColorAll Fingering is a simple and easy way to quickly begin playing music:

- GREEN** fingering numbers = play these notes on the **A string**
- GOLD** fingering numbers = play these notes on the **D string**
- BLUE** fingering numbers = play these notes on the **G string**
- RED** fingering numbers = play these notes on the **C string**

0=open string; 1=1st finger; 2=2nd finger; 3=3rd finger; 4=4th finger
